## CORONER'S OFFICE UPDATE ON HOMICIDES AND FIRE FATALITIES

The Sacramento Coroner's Office is investigating the cause of death for three apparent homicide victims who died on 01/05/07 and two children who received fatal injuries in a home fire on 01/06/07:

- 1) **January Audrea Keene** (DOB: 01/29/1976; Coroner case # 07-00089) died on 01/05/07 at 0125 hours at the University of California Davis Medical Center. The cause of death as determined by autopsy is "Gunshot Wound of Head". Circumstances of the shooting are pending further investigation by the Sacramento Police Department.
- 2) **Unidentified Adult Male** (Coroner case # 07-00099) died on 01/05/07 at 1008 hours. His body was found deceased in a field along Hedge Drive, south of Fruitridge Road. The cause of death as determined by autopsy is "Gunshot Wound of Chest". The decedent's identity is pending further investigation. Circumstances of the shooting are under investigation by the Sacramento Police Department.
- 3) **Favian Reyes** (DOB: 06/08/1988; Coroner case # 07-00111) died on 01/05/07 at 2241 hours at the University of California Davis Medical Center. The cause of death has not yet been determined. The circumstances are under investigation by the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department.
- 4) **Annie Bienh** (DOB: 09/13/1997; Coroner case # 07-00118) died on 01/06/07 at 0944 hours at a home in the 5700 block of Wallace Avenue in Sacramento. A fire started in the home around 0930 hours on Saturday morning. Annie sustained fatal injuries and was declared deceased at the scene. The cause of death has not yet been determined.
- 5) **Kyle Bienh** (DOB: 08/29/1999; Coroner case # 07-00119) was also injured in the same fire as his sister Annie. He was transported to the University of California Davis Medical Center where he was declared deceased at 1027 hours. The cause of death has not yet been determined. The circumstances of the fire are under investigation by the Sacramento Fire Department.
