



Cemetery Advisory Commission
Alder Creek Hill Cemetery | Prairie City Cemetery



Thirteen bodies were found and local historians believe it was the cemetery for an early mining town named Prairie City. The excavated remains were reburied at Mormon Island Cemetery (Mormon Island Relocation Cemetery).

The site of the Prairie City Cemetery, that once served the bustling gold rush town of Prairie City, was re-located during construction of the Prairie City Road and Highway 50 Interchange in May 1997. It was used between 1853 and at least 1872 and may have first been known as the Alder Creek Hill Cemetery as early as 1852. It was likely used by the citizens of Prairie City and other surrounding communities. Please visit the Mormon Island Relocation Cemetery on Shadowfax Road off Green Valley
